

# VOLUNTEER GUIDELINE AND AGREEMENT

- I will arrive by 4:45pm.
- I will fulfill my position until released by the CCT staff member. The shift will be considered completed.
- I will dress warm and will be prepared to perform job regardless of weather. This includes but is not limited to, extremely cold temperatures, rain and wind.
- I will not leave my position until a replacement has arrived.
- I will use the communication device as instructed.
- I will use the protective equipment provided to me as instructed.
- I will do everything necessary to ensure the public safety as well as my personal safety.
- I agree to not consume alcohol while working my position.
- I will inform the CCT contact person if I am unable to perform my position by 3pm the day before I am scheduled to volunteer.
- I will conduct myself in a manner becoming of the Christmas Cruise Thru.
- I will not use profanity.
- I will return all equipment provided to me at the end of each shift.
- I agree to radio for police assistance rather than handle the situation on my own.
- Compensation will be allowed for volunteers who are signed in and signed out by the CCT Staff.
- You must be signed up on the CCT Volunteer Page in order to be considered a volunteer that can be compensated. See a CCT Staff member if you need assistance, or you do not have the internet.
